

Description of Change to the Customer:

As part of Intel's continuing improvement efforts, Intel is standardizing the referenced header name on all Intermediate Box and Shipping Box labels pertaining to the Country of Origin and the Country Code header names. The hard coded referenced headers *Country of Origin* and *Country Code* printed on Intermediate Box and Shipping Box labels will now be abbreviated to *COO*.

Only the label header value referenced is changing. This change brings a conformity in the use of the referenced headers on all Intermediate Box and Shipping Box labels across Intel (including any custom labels required).

Below are two Before/After visual examples of the change which customers can apply broadly to any of the standard/custom labels being placed on Intermediate Box and Shipping Box labels shipped from Intel.

Customer Impact of Change and Recommended Action:

This notification is intended only to inform. Intel considers this a Minor Change, impacting label content, not products. There is no change to the Form, Fit, Function, Quality or Reliability of any product as a result of this change. This change applies to Intermediate Box and Shipping Box labels on any product shipped from Intel.

Intel will not be relabeling any previously placed labels on packaged boxes. Additionally, there is no expected time frame to deplete or ship the previously labeled & packaged material. Therefore, customers may experience a cross over period of seeing shipments with labels showing both the older hard coded header values and the new hard coded header values on labels. However, effective immediately, Intel's label system will start the transition process one label at a time and continue until all impacted labels have been updated accordingly by the end of 2022.

It may be appropriate for customers to notify their internal/inbound receiving departments of these changes to ensure they are aware and prepared.
